**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Birchin Lane, Brindle from approximately the southern boundary of the property named Brookside Cottage for an approximate distance of 50m in an Easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1625 hours on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2025 until 2359 hours on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair works to a leaking water main to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
